Minutes of February 4, 2014 General Membership Meeting

- I Call to Order and Introductions – President John Williams called the meeting to order at 7:05pm.
- II Guest Speakers: Greg Pearson and Steve Oleson
- “The Art of Falconry: Hunting with Hawks and Falcons”**
- Greg, a PSNA member, and Steve have served as President of the Texas Hawking Association, one of the largest hawking associations in North America. Both have falconry licenses and permits from the US and the state of Texas.
- III Membership meeting convenes: Minutes of Previous Meeting, Membership Report; Treasurer’s Report –motion made by Vicki McFarland and seconded by Sharon Bramblett to accept the minutes of the November, 2013 general meeting. No treasurer’s report was presented due to the absence of the Treasurer.
- IV. President’s Report and report on items of neighborhood interest
- Realignment of Gregg Manor Rd from the school campus to Riata Ford should begin soon, along with Re-signalization of US 290 from Riata Ford to Lexington St. It was reported that this project will take 7-8 months to complete.
- Signal Light at “Duett’s Corner” should begin installation soon
- Braker Lane has begun to be constructed between 973 and Taylor Lane
- Primary Election Day is Tuesday March 4. Early voting begins February 18
- May 10 Election Day for City of Manor Council Members and Manor ISD Trustees
- Manor Development continues: Wal-Mart opens Feb. 19; Medical Tower is under construction; Bell Farms, Shadow Glen, and Presidential Glenn all are opening new sections of Construction.

- V Reports from members – Emergency Services District 12 Commissioner Ron Fowler reported that ESD 12 is getting ready to build the fire station on Hogeys Road. This will be a 24/7 operation but no ambulance will be attached to the station. He also reported that ESD 12 has realized a \$40,000 increase in income due to the 2% rate increase. Two new custom built fire engines have been ordered because the engines currently in use are “worn out”. He also reported that ESD 12 meetings are held on the second Tuesday of each month beginning at 6:30 p.m. at the Manor Fire Station.
- Ann Brockenbrough has been in communication with the developers of the Hidden Lakes subdivision located at Parsons and Lockwood Roads. This parcel is 404 acres and Anne is working with the developer to see if the parcel would qualify for partial funding for a ranch to keep the landscape intact.
